Parents/Guardians of Grade 12 Students,

Congratulations! Your son or daughter has made it to their graduation year, and we wish you all the best as you prepare to celebrate that exciting occasion with them. It is only eight months until June 25th, 2008 and the LCI Grad Banquet and Convocation Ceremony.

There are several events linked with Grad celebrations that are important for parents to be informed of. For this reason, we will have a Grade 12 Parent Graduation meeting on Thursday, November 20 at 7:30pm, in the Landmark Collegiate Library. I invite you to attend and to bring any questions, comments or concerns you may have at that time.

Please take note, as well, of the following Grad related items:

1. Graduation Photos are scheduled for Monday, February 2, 2009 at the school. Pictures are taken by Lifetouch Photographers and students will have opportunity to schedule appointments during the two weeks prior to picture day. All payments will be made directly to Lifetouch.
2. The Graduation Convocation and Banquet is scheduled on June 25th, at the Prairie Rose E.M.C. and at the Landmark Collegiate gym. These events comprise the official Hanover School Division sponsored Graduation activities. The school Principal is ultimately responsible for the planning of these events.
3. Each graduate will receive tickets for three guests to the Graduation Banquet.
4. Landmark Collegiate tradition includes several unofficial, non-school sponsored grad events. It is up to parents and students to plan and carry out these events. They often include activities such as a boat cruise, an after-party following the Graduation ceremony, and even a spring ski trip to Banff. Divisional policy does not permit the use of school-time, or the use of school facilities during the school day for the planning or organizing of these events. We encourage parent and student organizers to keep student safety at the center of the planning of all such events.
5. The graduation class traditionally orders Grad Wear to commemorate their grad year. This year, two of the grade 12 students; Kristy and Jessica are organizing the clothing order.
